

Jay Hull attended as a guest.

As is done at the beginning of every meeting, Council members noted UMCOP accomplishments since the previous meeting, which included: Wednesday Church is going well; everyone enjoyed participating in the Fall Fun Day and Soup Supper Potluck; the Men's Group built a ramp at the home of Debbie Kilps; Church of the Pines and Ascension Lutheran held a combined youth gathering for 6th through 10th graders, and are planning to do this on a regular bases; an article appeared in The Lakeland Times, with a photo of Jim (JJ) and Barbara Jurries, telling about a memorial plaque that reads "James (JJ) and Barbara Jurries Legacy Garden since 1975" and will be placed in the flower garden under the church sign; there was a photo of members of Church of the Pines and Pastor Mark in The Lakeland Times presenting a check for \$2,500 to the Lakeland Pantry directory for the purchase of food for the pantry; a successful Leadership Orientation was held; Pastor Appreciation Sunday was celebrated with gifts for the pastor and a cake was served during Coffee Fellowship; and United Women in Faith Sunday was celebrated with members of the group leading worship and hosting Coffee Fellowship.



Life provides the cup, YOU choose how to fill it


Today let's work towards filling our cups with gratitude, forgiveness, joy, words of affirmation, resilience, positivity; and kindness, gentleness and love for others.

An Unlikely Advent






